

PREBLE BOYS BASKETBALL CAMPS 2009

The Preble boys' basketball staff will be conducting 2 separate basketball camps this summer. The first camp is for boys entering grades 2-9 in the 2009-2010 school year and will be a well-rounded fundamental camp focusing on all aspects of basketball. The 6-9 graders will also be introduced to weight training, plyometrics, and agility drills designed for basketball. The second camp will be designed differently, with a focus on offensive skills and will be offered for boys entering grades 8 and 9 only. There will be a cap of 32 boys for the second camp.

Once again, there will be a camp store for the campers. You may choose to put money in the camp bank to be used at all of the camps for food, beverages, and Preble basketball gear.
