Dear Prospective Golfers and Parents

This letter is to explain to you and your parents what expectations and rules you will have as you are trying out for the Preble Girl's Golf Team, and to prepare you for what will happen when you make the team. If you have any questions please contact me at rjohnso3@greenbay.k12.wi.us, or at home 920.569.4923.

The golf season will start this year on Monday, August 9th. Our home course is Royal Scot Golf Club, **4831 Church Rd. New Franken, WI 54229 - 920.866.2356**. Practice will begin at 9:00 and players are expected to be at the course on time and ready practice. Practice during the summer will last from 9:00 to approximately 11:15. Once school starts, practice will start at 3:30 and end around 5:30. You are expected to provide your own transportation to and from the golf course. Carpooling is recommended.

You will need to have your own clubs, balls, tees and golf or tennis shoes. No prior experience is necessary. Girls of all skill level are encouraged to join. If you have the equipment, we can teach you the rest. You will be required to carry your own clubs during practice and meets. Pull carts will not be allowed unless medically necessary. You should also be prepared for practicing in the rain. Practice will only be cancelled if there is lightning in the area, so you should have an umbrella, rain jacket and rain pants.

Team members and position on the team will be determined by the cumulative score of their qualifying rounds and by my evaluation. This year we have seven practices prior to our first meet. The team will consist of up to 15 players. The top five players will be varsity and the others will be on junior varsity. Everyone will get an opportunity to participate in at least one meet during the season.

It is your responsibility to get prepared for the season by golfing as much as you can during the summer. This year we will have five voluntary get together days at Royal Scot during July to give you a chance to play and meet the other players on the team. These days are completely voluntary and will not effect who makes the team. I'll notify you when these days are finalized

Preble Girl's Golf Team Rules

General Guidelines

- Every player is expected to follow the athletic code
- Every player is expected to follow school rules and be in class
- Profane language and poor attitude will not be tolerated
- Be a positive influence on your teammates and treat everyone with respect
- Be open minded and willing to accept instruction
- Golf is a game of honesty so any player caught cheating or lying about her score will not be allowed to participate in the next scheduled meet

School Conduct

Grades

- Eligibility requirements are outlined in the Co Curricular Code Book
- Golf may require you to miss a fair amount of school during the season. It is in your best interest to get all of your assignments ahead of time if you know you are going to miss class.
- Any player failing to keep in good academic standing in all of her classes will not be allowed to participate in meets. I cannot justify taking you out of class if you are receiving D or F grades. Grades will be checked during the season. I will also be in contact with your teachers about your academic and behavior in class.
- All restricted time (detentions) must be made up before you will be allowed to participate in any meets.

Attendance

- It is school policy that players be in attendance for the complete school day on the day of the meet and the day after the meet. If a player is unexcused for any part of the school day on the day of the meet, she is ineligible for the meet.
- Players are expected to be in all classes everyday. If you are unexcused on any given school day during the season, you will be ineligible for the next scheduled contest.

Practice Conduct

Punctuality

- It is expected that players are to be at the course and ready to practice when practice starts. Being in the parking lot in your car doesn't count as ready to practice.

Attendance

- It is expected that players will be at all practices unless sick. If you cannot make a practice for any reason it is your responsibility to contact me prior to practice that day. During the summer you can contact me via email rjohnso3@greenbay.k12.wi.us or at home 920.569.4923 and during the school day you can contact me at Preble 391.2408 ext 1440 or stop by room 144.

Conduct at the Course

- We are guests at Royal Scot. Treat everyone at the course with the utmost respect. We want to show everyone we have a quality program and give Preble Girl's Golf a good name.
- Dress code at practice: A player must be attired appropriately. Inappropriate dress includes, but is not limited to, clothing displaying anything related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco or inappropriate language or gestures.
- It is your responsibility to take care of the course. Replace divots, fix ball marks on greens and rake the sand traps.
- Any player guilty of inappropriate conduct (throwing clubs, swearing, etc...) will not participate in the next scheduled meet.

Meet Conduct

- A player improperly attired will not be allowed to tee off. Each of our players will be attired in either slacks, golf skirt or golf shorts, collared shirt and golf or tennis shoes. If the player removes an outer garment during play, and the clothing underneath is illegal, that player shall receive a warning for their first offense, and if they fail to correct the problem or commit a second offense, they will be disqualified from competition for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Inappropriate dress includes, but is not limited to, clothing displaying anything relating to drugs, alcohol, tobacco or inappropriate language or gestures.
- A player is expected to exhibit good sportsmanship at all times. Players seen throwing or burying clubs, swearing or committing other acts of unsportsmanlike conduct will receive a warning for the first violation, a two-stroke penalty for the second violation, and be disqualified for the third violation. In addition, the player will miss the next two scheduled events.

Bus/Van Conduct

- Players are to be seated and wearing seat belts if the vehicle is so equipped
- It is your responsibility to clean up after yourself when we leave the bus or van
- Players are to act respectfully and not be a distraction to the driver

Equipment Requirements

- You need to provide your own clubs, bag, tees and balls for practice and meets
- In away meets, players should carry with them a duffel bag which includes the following:
 - An extra set of clothes and a towel in case of rain
 - Sunscreen
 - Hat, gloves and hand warmers for meets later in the fall when the weather is colder
 - Snacks or money to buy snacks or food on the way home
- Players should also carry an umbrella, rain clothes and a towel in or on their golf bag
- Always carry enough tees and golf balls
